## RECOMMENDED PLACES TO MOOR

In addition to the ports and marinas listed above, we can also anchor in many coves and beaches such as:

1. **SES FONTANELLES** (mooring of between 4 and 7 metres deep)
2. **ALGAIARENS** (mooring of between 6 and 9 metres)
3. **CALA PREGONDA** (mooring around 3 metres)
4. **CALA BINIBÈQUER** (mooring of between 6 and 9 metres)
5. **CALA MITJANA** (mooring of between 3 and 5 metres)
6. **CALA MACARELLA Y MACARELLETA** (mooring around 6 metres)
7. **CALA TURQUETA** (mooring of between 4 and 6 metres)
8. **CALA COVES** (mooring of between 3 and 5 metres)

# Recommendations

## RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE SAILING

- Check the weather forecast, download the weather apps.
  1. WINDGURU >>> [www.windguru.com](http://www.windguru.com)
  2. AEMET >>> [www.aemet.es](http://www.aemet.es)
- Plan your route, the main ports, beaches, bays etc It is recommended to reserve moorings and anchorage at least a month beforehand.
- Do not bring hard-sided suitcases storage space on the boat is limited.
- Bring footwear that is appropriate for the boat: boat-shoes or wet-shoes.
- Bring water it is important to always be hydrated on-board.
- Bring Sun-protection suntan lotion, cap, UV sunglasses.
- Bring a coat/jacket for the night and sailing.
- Bring snorkel gear.

## ONBOARD RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strictly follow the skipper's rules, onboard they are the boss!
- Be organised to prevent accidents.
- Don't run on the deck.
- When the boat is manoeuvring try not to obstruct the skipper.

## RECOMMENDATIONS IN CASE OF SEASICKNESS

- Take one or two anti-seasickness tablets one hour before sailing.
- Avoid staying into the cabins whilst sailing.
- Try to avoid being in an area which is in direct contact with the wind.
- Look at a fixed point on the horizon.
- Alcoholic drinks and dairy products can aggravate seasickness whilst sailing.

# Suggested itinerary

## MENORCA SAILING ITINERARY MAHÓN ( 7 DAYS / 90 NAUTICAL MILES )

We recommend that you check the weather forecast before you embark on the charter. If the weather is good, as it should be, it is best to start the route to the north. If the weather is bad, it is better to start south and travel towards the north to see if the weather has improved. If it was not, our advice would be to return to the south.



### MAHÓN >>> ES GRAU (10nm)

Our journey through Menorca will begin at the port of Mahón located to the north of the island. We will head north along the Menorcan coast, passing Es Castells, San Esteve cove or the S'Albufera des Grau Natural Park, where the village of Es Grau is located. We will be able to anchor with a buoy on the Island of es Colom. The island has two pristine beaches and spectacular cliffs.



### ES GRAU >>> FORNELLS (13nm)

We will be heading to Fornells, a quiet and pleasant town, which is only 13 nautical miles away. Near Fornells we will find Cala Tirant, Cala Fornes, Cala N'estàsia where we can anchor the boat easily. We can also rent a buoy in Puerto de Fornells.



### FORNELLS >>> CALA MORELL (18nm)

This small 80m cove on the north coast of Menorca is surrounded by cliffs with dramatic rock faces. The centre point of this cove is undoubtedly its prehistoric caves. If we are looking for a cove to relax on the sand, this is not the ideal one since there is no sand!





#### **CALA MORELL >>> CIUTADELLA (10nm)**

Undoubtedly, this is the longest day of the cruise, 26 nautical miles, but it will be worth it. We will find a multitude of coves that we can visit, each one with its different charm, we recommend: Cala Ciutadella, Cala Macarella, Cala Macarelleta, Cala del Pilar, Cala Brut, Cala Galdana or Cala en Bosch. In the Ciutadella or Macarella coves we can anchor easily.



#### **CIUTADELLA >>> CALA GALDANA (12nm)**

La Cala Galdana is one of the most famous and popular bays on the south coast of the Island of Menorca, and it offers many services for both young and old. It is particularly good place to stop if we need to restock anything for the boat. If we feel like stretching our legs climb to the viewpoint of Galdana - this is highly recommended.



#### **CALA GALDANA >>> BINIBEQUER (18nm)**

For this leg of the journey we will sail for 18 miles to find Cala Binibequer located south of Mahon. Its contrast of turquoise waters and fine white sand make it one of the most pretty beaches in the area. If we like diving, we should go to Cala Binisafua where we will swim with a multitude of fish. We can anchor in the cove of Binibequer.



#### **BINIBEQUER >>> MAHÓN (10nm)**

Our route will end up returning to Mahón for 10 nautical miles. We can make a stop at one of the nearest beaches and coves, we recommend Cala Cap de Favàritz, the Beach in Tortuga or the Cala Presili.
